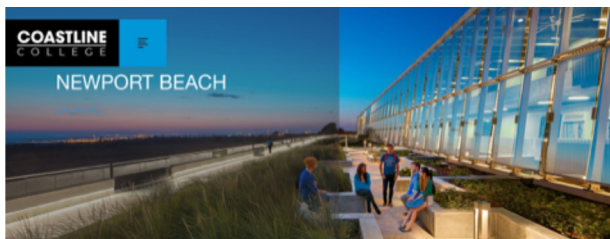
Sessions #7
